AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 3: FINANCE; CHAPTER 4: SCHEDULE OF FEES; SECTION 3-4-1: SCHEDULE OF FEES TO BE PAID TO THE CITY OF MORROW, OF THE CITY OF MORROW CODE OF ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR CODIFICATION; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MORROW HEREBY ORDAINS

WHEREAS, the City of Morrow (“City”) is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia, and is authorized pursuant to Article 6 of the City Charter to levy fees delineated therein;

WHEREAS, the City is further authorized pursuant to Section 6.17 of the City Charter to levy any other tax or fee allowed by law;

WHEREAS, various portions of the City Charter, the City’s Code of Ordinances, and provisions of State law provide additional authority for the imposition collection of various fees; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to add Vehicle Immobilization Fees to the official Schedule of Fees that may be levied and collected within the City;

WHEREAS, At the discretion of the Mayor and City Council, they have the authority to adjust fees to cover administrative costs.

SECTION 1. Code Section Amended. Title 3 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Morrow, Georgia, is hereby amended by adding the following to Chapter 4.; Section 3-4-1 Schedule of Fees as follows:

PD-14	Vehicle Immobilization Fee	\$100.00 annually

The City of Morrow, Georgia, its Departments, and authorized employees may charge the referenced fees and costs on behalf of the City, as specified pursuant to Code of Ordinances

Section 3-4-1 and the Schedule of Fees. Said fees and costs paid shall be remitted to the City of Morrow.

SECTION 2. Codification. This ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the State of Georgia.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by a decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which such portions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Approval of Execution. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Ordinance. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any document which may be necessary to effectuate this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. Repeal of Conflicting Provision. Except as otherwise provided herein, all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.

PREAMBLE AND FINDINGS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP, CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the City of Morrow, Georgia (“City”) are the Mayor and Council thereof;

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the City desires to modify the zoning designation of certain properties located in the City; and,

WHEREAS, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Morrow, Georgia, will be positively impacted by the adoption of this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA:

Section 1. The following properties are hereby rezoned from Community University Planned District (“CUPD”) to General Business/Commercial District (“BG”):

(A) 1546 Millirons Way, Morrow, Georgia, with Parcel Number 12146A B018 and more particularly depicted by said Parcel Number on the Clayton County, Georgia tax map shown in Exhibit “A,” a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

(B) 5765 Jonesboro Road, Morrow, Georgia, with Parcel Number 12146A B012 and more particularly depicted by said Parcel Number on the Clayton County, Georgia tax map shown in Exhibit “A,” a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

(C) 1555 Millirons Way, Morrow, Georgia, with Parcel Number 12146A B011 and more particularly depicted by said Parcel Number on the Clayton County, Georgia tax map shown in Exhibit "A," a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Such rezoning to be noted on the City of Morrow Official Zoning Map approved by Mayor and Council as soon as reasonably possible following adoption of this Ordinance by the Zoning Administrator along with an editorial note on the City of Morrow Official Zoning Map approved by Mayor and Council specifying the parcel(s) affected by this Ordinance and the date of adoption of this Ordinance. Until the rezoning is indicated on the City of Morrow Official Zoning Map approved by Mayor and Council, this Ordinance shall govern over the City of Morrow Official Zoning Map approved by Mayor and Council to the extent of any discrepancy between this Ordinance and the City of Morrow Official Zoning Map approved by Mayor and Council.

The rezoning shall be subject to the following condition:

1. Fencing on the affected properties shall be subject to approval by the City Manager or his/her designee to ensure that the aesthetics are consistent with the development of neighboring properties.

Section 2. The preamble of this Ordinance shall be considered to be and is hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the State of Georgia and the City of Morrow.

- (a) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that all sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon their enactment, believed by the Mayor and Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.
- (b) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. It is hereby further declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.
- (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the Mayor and Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Ordinance and that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional, enforceable, and of full force and effect.

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA TO DESIGNATE AN URBAN REDEVELOPMENT AREA IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 61, TITLE 36 OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA, WHICH URBAN REDEVELOPMENT AREA CONSISTS OF GEOGRAPHIC AREAS WITHIN THE CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA CURRENTLY STRUGGLING WITH BLIGHT AND ECONOMIC DECLINE, AND IN WHICH GEOGRAPHIC AREAS THE CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA DESIRES TO PROMOTE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THIS TRANSACTION AND EFFECTUATE THIS INTENT.

WHEREAS, Chapter 61 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, entitled the “Urban Redevelopment Law,” as amended (the “Urban Redevelopment Law”), authorizes the City of Morrow, Georgia (“Morrow”) to designate an “urban redevelopment area,” which is defined to mean a “pocket of blight” which the City Council of Morrow designates as appropriate for an urban redevelopment project; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Redevelopment Law defines “pocket of blight” to mean an area which by reason of the presence of a substantial number of slum, deteriorated, or deteriorating structures; predominance of defective or inadequate street layout; faulty lot layout in relation to size, adequacy, accessibility, or usefulness; unsanitary or unsafe conditions; deterioration of site or other improvements; tax or special assessment delinquency exceeding the fair value of the land; the existence of conditions which endanger life or property by fire and other causes; by having development impaired by airport or transportation noise or by other environmental hazards; or any combination of such factors substantially impairs or arrests the sound growth of Morrow, retards the provisions of housing accommodations, or constitutes an economic or social liability and is a menace to the public health, safety, morals, or welfare in its present condition and use; and

WHEREAS, Morrow has previously designated certain areas as “pocket of blight” pursuant to the Urban Redevelopment Law; and

WHEREAS, after careful study and investigation, Morrow desires to designate the area which is more particularly described in Exhibit A attached to this resolution, as an “urban redevelopment area” as well;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Morrow that the area which is more particularly described in Exhibit A attached to this resolution, is hereby determined to be a “pocket of blight,” by reason of the presence of a substantial number of deteriorated or deteriorating structures; predominance of defective or inadequate street layout; faulty lot layout in relation to size, adequacy, accessibility, or usefulness; unsanitary or unsafe conditions; deterioration of site or other improvements; and the existence of conditions which endanger life or property by fire and other causes which substantially impairs or arrests the

sound growth of Morrow or constitutes an economic or social liability and is a menace to the public health, safety, morals, or welfare in its present condition and use, and that such area is therefore designated as appropriate for an urban redevelopment project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rehabilitation, conservation, or redevelopment, or a combination thereof, of such area is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety, morals, or welfare of the residents of Morrow.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any and all resolutions in conflict with this resolution be and the same are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of Morrow.
